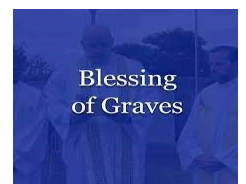

Gift Aid: Letter and 2 forms have been posted inviting parishioners to sign and return. This will allow our parish to claim "Gift Aid" on your weekly contribution to Clontibret, Doohamlet and Annyalla Churches. These forms will be posted to people who contributed €250 or more per year (€5 per week) in their parish envelope or made a once off donation and received a receipt. This scheme is already in place in Muckno Parish and is a vital extra source of income.
