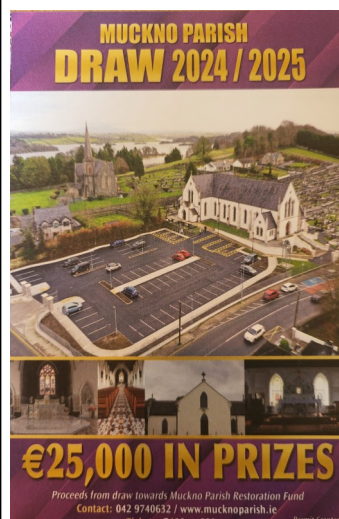
Prayer for the Dead for November
