Cathedral and Restoration – gathering opinions

As you are aware, St. Macartan's Cathedral restoration project has been ongoing over recent years. The present phase, the substantial work on the tower and spire is almost complete. You may have noticed the lowering of the scaffolding which has unveiled the remedial works to date. This is phase 3 of the restoration work, phases 1 and 2 which repaired the roof and restored the north transept have already been completed.

To ensure successful completion of all seven stages, we will need to call on the support and commitment of a wide audience, including parishioners, local businesses and friends both at home and abroad. As a first step, we are gathering opinions to help shape the fundraising plan. We will ask you to complete a short survey at the 7.30pm vigil Mass in St Mary's Clontibret this weekend Saturday 31st August. 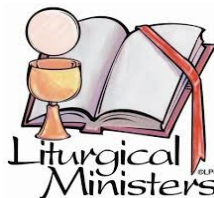
